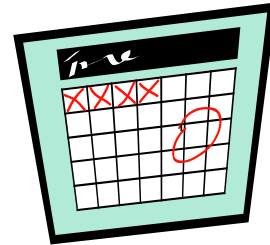

Fall/Winter Class Schedule

Stripe and Belt Promotions

To the right is the schedule for 2010 stripes and belt promotions. This schedule is for all White through Brown Belts. Everyone will get stripes and belts at the same time. The only exceptions may be students who train only once a week, in which case it may take longer to achieve such promotions.

Black Belt exams and promotions will be in January and June.

Kata

In the past we had kata assigned to each belt. Kata are no longer assigned to a specific belt. Now we will be teaching only one kata to everyone at the same time, regardless of belt color (white to green). This makes teaching easier and faster and all students will know the kata better. The old method of every belt being different made it difficult to help all students properly because there were so many different groups.

So the question of how can a white belt learn the same kata as a purple or green belt can be answered like this: it doesn't matter when you learn each of the different kata as long as you learn all of them by Brown belt.



Brown and Black belts will still learn specific kata for their next belt.
